Just a note to bring you up to date. At the LWBA meeting on September 25th, questions were raised which needed further answers. A follow up meeting of all the Lake Williams Special Tax District members is planned and will take place hopefully in November, 1988. First Selectman Richard Bauwens is waiting for a legal opinion on whether the Flood and Erosion Board can legally establish a special tax district to fund a portion of the purchase price of a State project. Look for his letter announcing the meeting. BE SURE TO ATTEND. This meeting is expected to end with a vote.

The September 25 LWBA was well attended and included State Senator Ken Przybysz, State Representative Edith Prague, First Selectman Richard Bauwens, the Riders from Lake Williams Campground and several of our neighbors from the west side of the lake. The first item discussed was the results of the poll (questionnaire) of members of the proposed tax district. While none of us wants to pay more taxes, the results demonstrated strong support for a tax district if it means saving Lake Williams. The results of the poll were:

LWBA members returned 64 questionnaires (out of 117 property owners or 54%) 14 opposed 50 in favor West Side owners returned 14 questionnaires (out of 20 property owners or 70%) 0 opposed 14 in favor Major property owners agreed in principle to a special tax district to save Lake Williams.

The boundaries of the proposed special tax district include all of LWBA, all of the islands, the west side lake property, major property owners Harold Leibman, Lake Williams Campground (formerly Kanters), Grand Lake Spa, Richard Cummings, selected Route 207 and Leonard Bridge Road properties.

Dick Bauwens presented an estimate by property of what the special tax district would mean to each property owner (see the enclosed attachment based on the 1978 assessment and an estimated bonding cost of 9% over 10 years.) He chose to be conservative (that is, on the high side.) Below are some examples:

Property Assessed at 1,400 the extra tax is \$ 22.27 per yr 12,020 191.24 25,040 398.39 39,690 631.47

It should be noted that the highest assessment in LWBA is just under \$40,000. The range in extra tax for all of the special tax district is from a low of \$5.57 to a high of \$1,145.

Below are some of the answers given for concerns which were raised at the meeting:

Termination of the special tax district can be written into the agreement.

The agreement between the State and the Gilman Brothers is still binding. (Note: the state did not purchase Savin Pond.)

- The option for bonding at 10, 15 or 20 years will be discussed at public meeting of the entire special tax district
- Addressing of lake problems, ie grass, speed boats etc is better addressed once the dam and water rights issues are resolved.
- The state has a program for cleaning up lake problems, but that should not be considered as a guarantee.
- The feeling at the meeting appeared to be that we should not drag our feet but should move forward. If this is dragged out we could wind up with nothing.

Bob Hathaway raised several issues which he felt need to be considered:

We need to be positive - remember that the value of our property is based on the existence of a lake. Lake Williams must be saved as a natural resource, not just a recreational area.

The state case against the Gilman Brothers is still pending.

- A tax district once established historically never disappears, we could be taxed and retaxed. What are the future legal and tax implications?
- How can we assure tax equity, what is an appropriate tax scheme? Some alternatives are based on town tax rolls, front footage, commercial use, use tax, etc.
- Lake health issues: ecology over use, safety issues, pollution, water quality, silt , vegetation
- Alternate funding programs open space programs, DEP, legislation

Dick Bauwens indicated he will prepare answers to many of these issues with the call of the meeting.

Also enclosed is a restatement of the 1987-88 expenses compared with the 1988-89 budget. Two additional exhibits reconcile the LWBA checking account and the Treasurer's annual report of 1987-88 expenses.

A nominating committee consisting of Mary Talar, Fern Trembley, and Mike Melville is looking for candidates for 1989-90. If you are interested or have suggestions please contact them or me.
