A motion was made to approve a tax rate of \$65.00 per taxable property, by Dawn Jacques and seconded by Lisa Santoro. After discussion, the motion was passed by role call vote, with 12 in favor and 9 opposed.

LWBA Treasurer Report - 2010/2011

The 2010-2011 Budget was \$10,695.00. Actual spent was \$8,015.60. The Board of Directors were able to manage our expenses well and spent \$2,679.40 less than our actual budget. This figure represents a 25% savings this year.

There is one outstanding invoice for the year 2010-2011 that could not be paid without approval from the association. The invoice is from Messier & Associates in the amount of \$416.00 for additional services requested in 2009-2010 which was outside the scope of the original contract. This item is on the agenda for today.

The Board of Directors implemented a new procedure for paying invoices. Each invoice requires a voucher to be completed and a receipt attached in order to be paid. The voucher includes the name of the individual requesting payment, address, date, description, amount, signature and invoice attached. The new procedure worked well and provides the treasurer and auditors a clear view of the item that was paid without looking in multiple places to understand the expense.

Beginning Checking Account Balance was \$1,933.49 less \$126.00 paid the previous Treasurer after the audit was complete and before the books were turned over to the new Treasurer due to the rescheduled Annual Meeting. Total member tax collected this year is \$8,117.50. Our actual expenses were \$8,015.60. The ending balance in our checking account is \$2,035.39.

Beginning balance in our Savings Account was \$4,802.69. Interest accrued was \$11.20. The ending balance in our savings account is \$4,813.89.

Total cash on hand (checking + savings) is \$6,849.28.
